AICUP President Joins Shapiro-Davis Higher Education Transition Advisory Committee

AICUP President Tom Foley has joined Governor-Elect Shapiro's Higher Education Transition Advisory Committee. One of seven advisory committees, these committees are made up of state leaders and policy experts with the goal of advising Mr. Shapiro and Mr. Davis on different policy areas. The Higher Education Transition Advisory Committee consists of 19 members from across the Commonwealth with varying areas of expertise. He joins AICUP presidents John Fry (Drexel), Barbara Altmann (F&M) and former UPenn Interim President Wendell Pritchett on the committee.

Tom brings much experience to this role, even beyond his education credentials. Chronologically speaking, he has served as a Pennsylvania State Cabinet member twice, a Special Assistant to the US Secretary of Labor, the President of the United Way of Pennsylvania and the Red Cross of SEPA, and the President of Mount Aloysius College before taking the role as President of AICUP. Tom has chaired over 10 different statewide boards and commissions and is currently serving as Co-Chair of Governor Wolf's Early Learning Investment Commission.

President Foley is honored to serve in this role and is looking forward to making a significant contribution to higher education policy in Pennsylvania.
