Past Due Payment Plans

Features:

- Manage past due accounts with flexible payment plan options
- Reduce collection agency expense and involvement
- Customer support for proactive communication
- Monitor activity and track success

Benefits:

- Retention/Re-enrollment of stopped out students
- Reduce outstanding receivables
- Reduce collection costs
- Increase efficiencies
- Integration, real-time and batch payment posting options

Past Due Payment Plans

Integrated

- Seamless experience from your ERP

Non-Integrated/Institution First

- Additional stand-alone instance
- For students who no longer have access
- File provided of student with balances

Non-Integrated/Consumer Entered

- Additional stand-alone instance
- Open to larger population
- Payer determines plan amount

Integrated, Past Due Payment Plans

Integration Process:

- Joint process with school and Nelnet's delivered Integration
- Identify the "term" or cohort of students
- Determine the number of payment plans offered, not exceeding 12 months
- Auto-debit configuration and timing
- School notifies students they are eligible, student sees eligibility at login
- Student selects payment option and auto-debit date
- Students will have direct access, 24/7 support, responsive design UX

Payment Processing

- Payment posting via EOD file
- Real-time Agreement Notification sent to ERP

Non-integrated, Institution First Plans

Process:

- Identify the cohort of students
- Determine the number of payment plans offered, not exceeding 12 months
- Auto-debit configuration and timing
- School provides the list of eligible students
 - As a file upload or manually enters in the Enterprise

Non-integrated, Institution First Plans

Process continued:

- Nelnet emails invitation to participate in payment plan (triggered by the file upload)
 - Configurable—up to 4 paragraphs in length
 - Student clicks link, creates user profile and sets up plan
 - Students will have direct access, 24/7 support, responsive design UX

Payment Posting:

- Manually extract a remittance report to upload to ERP
- Manually post payments

Non-integrated, Consumer Entered Plans

Process:

- Determine the number of payment plans offered, not exceeding 12 months
- School publishes or market/campaign to students the direct URL to Enterprise
- Student registers as a Payer in Enterprise
 - Completes the enrollment process for the payment plan
 - Student enters the amount of the plan
 - Students will have direct access, 24/7 support, responsive design UX

Payment Posting:

- Manually extract a remittance report to upload to ERP
- Manually post payments

Payment Plan Enrollment Fee

Semester, Past Due and International Payment Plan Bundle:

- **Enrollment Fee – Consumer Paid**
 - \$40 - 2 to 6 payments
 - \$60 - 7 to 12 payments
- **No monthly hosting or transaction fees charged to the school**
- **ACH, Credit/Debit Card payment options for Semester and Past Due**
 - Credit/Debit Card payments can use Discount or Service Fee
- **International Payment Plans using Convera**
