

AICUP Nobel Laureates

At least 66 Nobel Prize winners are known to have been affiliated with an AICUP college or university, including those working as a university researcher at the time of their award, an alum, or a faculty member hired after their award (this figure *excludes* honorary degrees). The 66 recipients were affiliated with UPenn (36), Carnegie Mellon (20), Haverford (5) and Swarthmore (5).
