

“Here’s Where Pennsylvania’s Out-of-State Students are Moving From” AICUP Press Release September 10, 2024

The following facts all come from IPEDS Data from the US Department of Education:

- Pennsylvania is the 2nd most popular destination for college in the US, on average, based on 17 years of data (data from 1988-2022).
- Origin states of AICUP out-of-state first-year students
- 21,000 first-year students annually matriculate to PA AICUP schools, which is $\frac{2}{3}$ of all out-of-state students moving to PA.

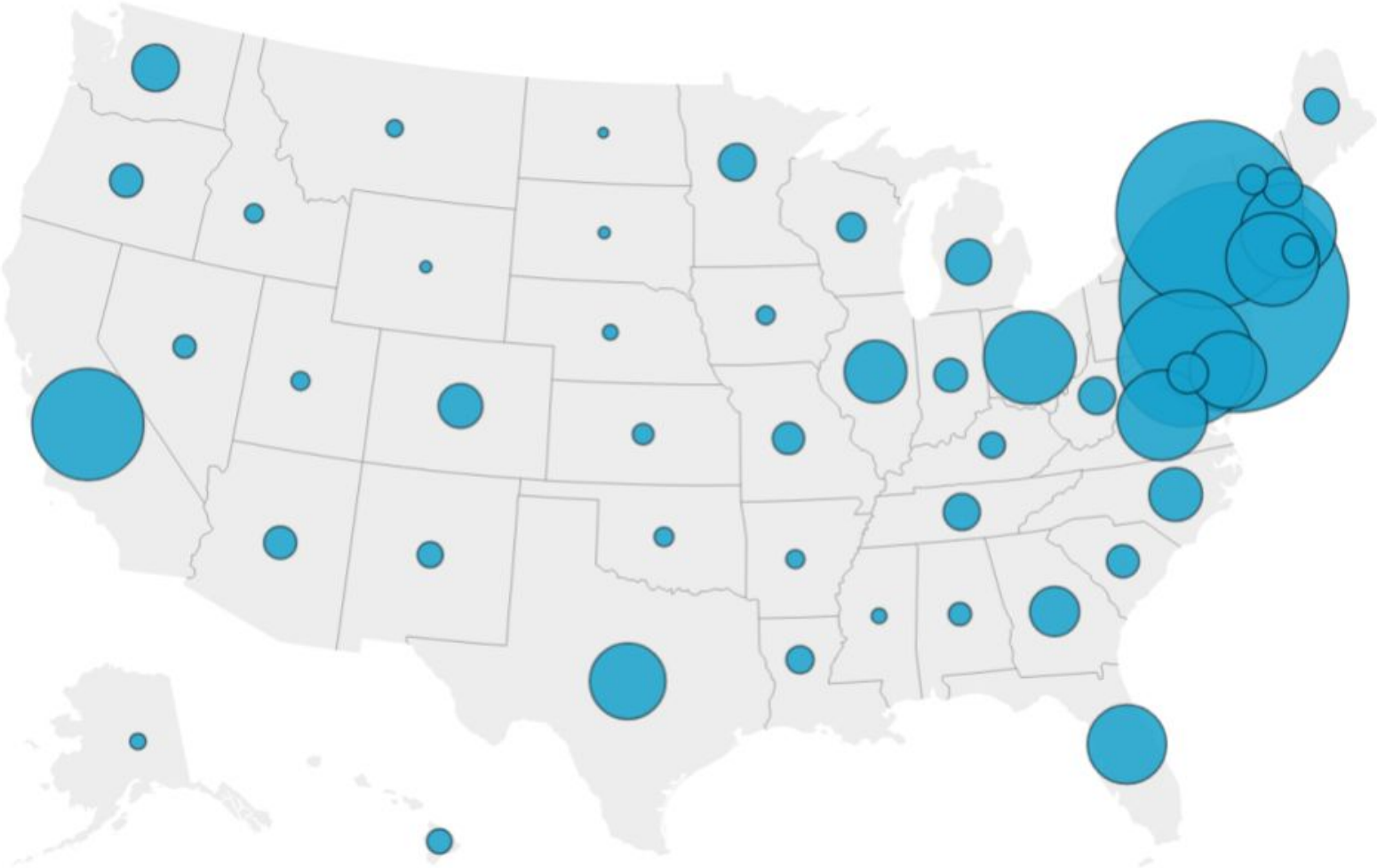
