

# AICUP SERVES LOW-INCOME STUDENTS (PELL)

AICUP schools enroll the most students from low- and middle-income families who are Pell Grant-eligible.

- ✓ 47% of all undergraduate Pell students at 4-year institutions in the state are enrolled at an AICUP college or university.
- ✓ 40 AICUP institutions have enrollments that consist of at least 30% Pell students.
- ✓ 19 AICUP institutions have enrollments that consist of at least 40% Pell students.
- ✓ 9 AICUP institutions have enrollments that consist of at least 50% Pell students.

9 of the 13 higher education institutions in Pennsylvania with enrollments consisting of 50% or more Pell students are AICUP colleges or universities.
