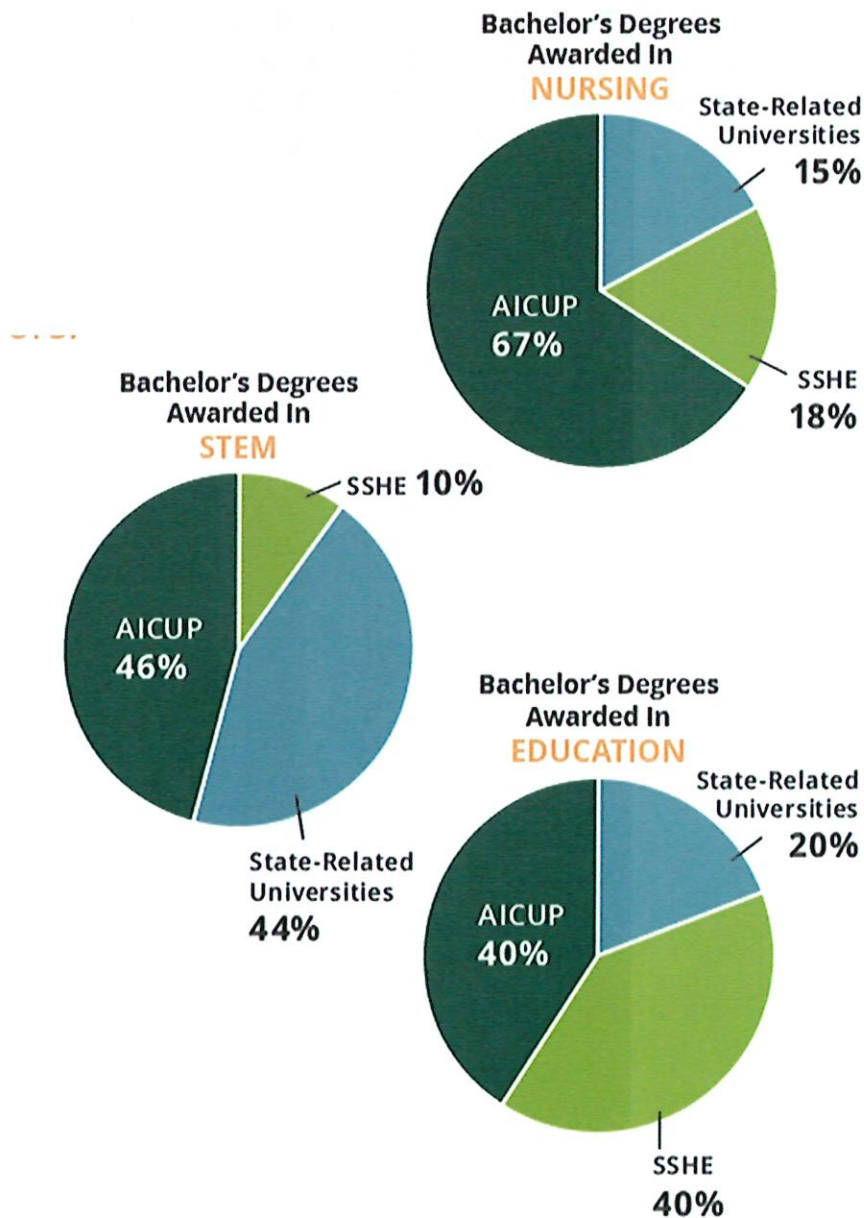


WHAT WE CONTRIBUTE TO: THE WORKFORCE

WHAT WE CONTRIBUTE TO: THE WORKFORCE

Pennsylvania students who attend an AICUP college or university continue to live and work in Pennsylvania after graduation.

80% of students who were Pennsylvania residents at enrollment in an AICUP college or university were still living and working in Pennsylvania five years after graduation.

15% of students who were non-residents of Pennsylvania at enrollment in an AICUP college or university found employment and were living in Pennsylvania five years after graduation.

AICUP colleges and universities bring tens of thousands of future workers to Pennsylvania every year.

30,000 out-of-state high school grads move to Pennsylvania (#2 in nation) every year to enroll at one of the Commonwealth's colleges or universities. Two-thirds of these students travel to PA specifically to attend an AICUP institution.
